



Peptides: Bremelanotide (PT-141)

Overview: Bremelanotide is used to treat sexual dysfunction or used to improve sexual performance in healthy patients. Bremelanotide produces multiple effects that include:

- Noticeable increase in desire
- Increased libido
- Increase in physical response
- Vaginal vasocongestion (women) and erection (men)
- Increase in pleasure/orgasm

Bremelanotide is a peptide hormone and melanocortin receptor agonist that has been approved under the commercial name Vyleesi to treat hypoactive sexual desire disorder (HSDD) in premenopausal women. It is also used off-label to sexual dysfunction in men. In premenopausal women with female sexual dysfunctions, self-administered subcutaneous bremelanotide was found to be safe, effective, and well tolerated. Diabetic men with ED who were part of a phase IIB trial reported significant increases in the International Index of Erectile Function (IIEF) scores after receiving bremelanotide injections. Bremelanotide has been used off-label by healthy men and women who want to enhance sexual performance.

Combination Therapies: The following products can be co-administered to potentiate effects

- PDE-5 inhibitor
- Testosterone
- Arousal Cream
- Oxandrolone/Stanozolol
- Trimix (any ICI)
- Oxytocin
- Testosterone nasal gel (as needed before sex)

Suggested Dose:

Injection: 1.75 mg-2.5 mg as needed 1 hour prior to sex
