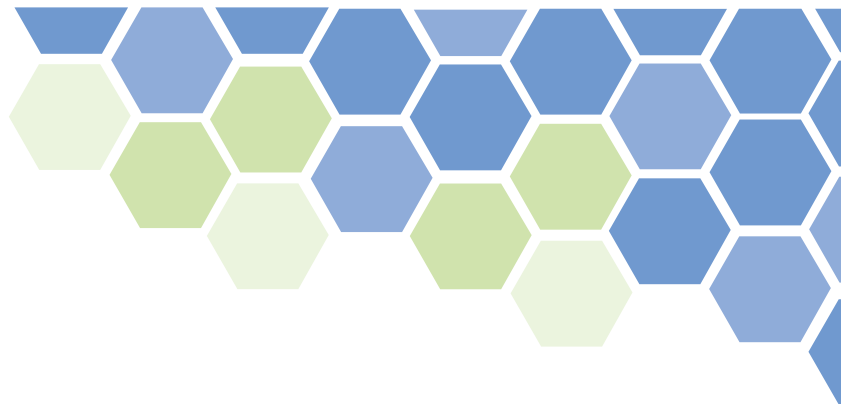




NAD+ Injections

NAD+ (nicotinamide adenine dinucleotide) is a coenzyme found throughout the body. It helps support cellular energy production, metabolism, DNA repair, immune health, and overall wellness.

Because NAD+ levels naturally decline with age, supplementation may be considered for patients looking to support cellular function, healthy aging, and vitality under provider guidance.

NAD+ injections may help support:

- **Cellular Energy** – NAD+ helps mitochondria convert nutrients into usable energy.
- **Metabolic Support** – NAD+ plays a role in processes that help the body utilize glucose and fatty acids for energy.
- **Healthy Aging Support** – NAD+ is involved in cellular repair pathways, including processes related to DNA repair and gene expression.
- **Mental Clarity** – By supporting cellular energy metabolism, NAD+ may help support cognitive wellness and mental acuity.
- **Overall Wellness** – NAD+ contributes to functions involved in energy, repair, immune health, sleep patterns, and vitality.

Suggested Dose

Use as directed. Typical use is 0.5 mL injected intramuscularly or subcutaneously. Dose may be increased up to 1 mL per injection as tolerated, with use ranging from once daily to every other day unless otherwise directed.

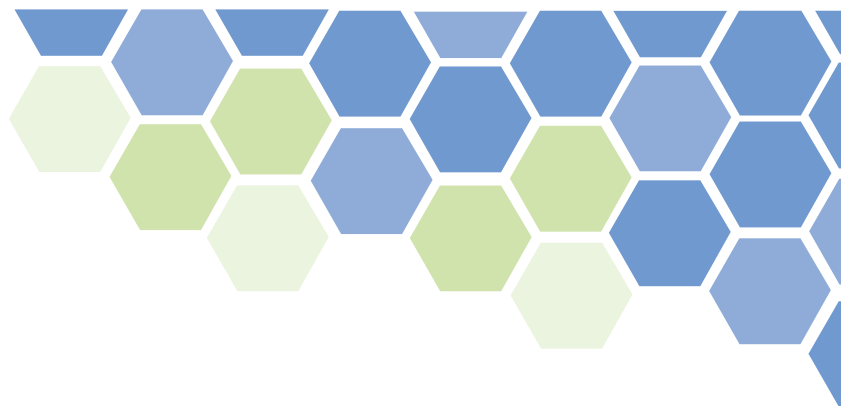
Dosage depends on the intent of treatment, product form, and the patient's response. Patients should follow their provider's instructions on how much and how often to utilize NAD+ injections.

How do I Administer NAD+ Injections?

Typically, NAD+ injections may be administered as a subcutaneous or intramuscular injection, depending on provider guidance, dosage, and product form. Some NAD+ products may require preparation before use.

Defy Medical offers access to self-administered NAD+ injections, along with injection materials and instructions needed to administer them. Patients should follow all pharmacy and provider instructions carefully.

What is NAD+?

NAD+ is a coenzyme, which means it helps enzymes complete important chemical reactions in the body. These reactions include processes involved in converting food into energy, supporting metabolism, and maintaining cellular function.

Within the cell, NAD+ helps mitochondria create ATP, one of the body's core energy sources. NAD+ is also involved in sirtuin activity, DNA repair, gene expression, and other processes connected to cellular health and healthy aging.

Additional NAD+ Options

Defy Medical also offers NAD+ nasal spray options for qualifying patients who prefer a non-injection form. With nasal application, NAD+ is absorbed through the nasal mucosa and can reach the bloodstream without going through the digestive tract.

Combination Therapies:
